at Weinberg Village is an innovative community designed to preserve and protect the dignity and well-being of individuals with Alzheimer's disease and other illnesses associated with aging as they face challenges of their late life stages. We are here to support them, within their individual capacity, in a therapeutic, safe, comfortable, loving, and peaceful environment.

The Answers . . .

The Orloff Memory Support Unit is a completely self-contained unit designed to provide a secure environment which allows residents with dementia, who often wander and become disoriented, to move about freely and safely, both indoors and out, without a sense of confinement.

The Orloff Memory Support Unit is designed with visual clues throughout the area to help orient residents. Bright lighting, slip-resistant and glare-reducing floors, color coded rooms, handrails and uncluttered hallways, easily accessed bathroom facilities, and short distances between bedrooms and activity rooms all help minimize confusion and compensate for cognitive losses.

Our new, enclosed patio and monitored pathways allow residents to safely enjoy the outdoors with maximum independence.

The Unit is secure at all levels, including perimeter security and monitored doors.

A Comfortable Home

The Orloff Memory Support Unit is a clean, comfortable, cheerful, homelike environment where residents are always treated with kindness and respect.

Family members are welcome to make their loved one's living quarters as homelike as possible with photos, memorabilia and other personal items.

We encourage family members to visit as often as they like.



Medical Care



The Orloff Memory Support Unit has routine access to specialty physicians and other health care providers who understand the ongoing needs of illnesses associated with aging. Residents may choose to use our in-house physicians or continue to use their own private physicians. We will provide transportation to appointments within a twenty mile radius.

The Plan of Care

When a new resident comes to the Orloff Memory Support Unit, our professional staff assesses the needs of the resident and works with the resident and the family to develop an individualized plan of care. The plan is continually reviewed and adjusted as the needs of the resident change.



Family Participation

Nobody knows your loved one's needs and life story better than you do. At the Orloff Memory Support Unit, family members are an integral part of the care planning team. We all work together to provide the highest quality of life possible for the person you love.

The Staff

The professional staff at the Orloff Memory Support Unit includes nurses, dietitians, physicians, social workers, activity directors, and therapists.

There is a professional staff on duty twenty-four hours a day.

All staff members are professionally trained in caring for the special needs of people with declined cognitive abilities and know how to help and guide them in ways that are reassuring and encouraging.



Activity Planning

Because we understand that structured routine and familiar daily activities are fundamental to the well-being of people with dementia, we strive to provide meaningful activities geared to the needs, interests, talents and desires of each individual resident.



Activities are designed to maximize stimulation while minimizing triggers of agitation and frustration.

Food Service

Because people with illnesses associated with aging are often confused about time, meals and snacks are available twenty-four hours a day.

Staff supervises all meals and snacks, paying close attention to the physical capabilities, restrictions, and abilities of each resident.

All food is prepared under the direction of a dietitian familiar with the needs of the elderly and of people with memory impairment. Dietary laws strictly observed
